

SERVICES Garbage, Recycling, Green Waste, Bulky Items

ALL YOUR RECYCLING AND WASTE NEEDS, HANDLED BY ONE PROVIDER Republic Services provides garbage, recycling, green waste, and bulky items services to Rancho Cordova residents. This guide provides details of these services.

Extra Trash

If you have extra trash that will not fit in your cart with the lid closed, please call **(916) 638-9000** at least 24 hours in advance of your regular collection day to arrange for a pickup of the extra trash. Customer service will provide cost and scheduling information.

Payment Options

You may pay:

- 1) By mail.
- 2) With a credit card or checking account by calling **(916) 638-9000** or **(877) 692-9729**, by filling out the form on the back of your invoice, by using the My Resource App on your smartphone device, or by visiting republiconline.com.
- 3) Automatically by checking account or credit card. Call for enrollment forms.

Cart Placement

Place carts on the street by 6:00 a.m. on your collection day. Please place carts side-by-side in the street three (3) feet apart and with the wheels three (3) feet from the curb. Keep all carts three (3) feet apart from anything that may block the collection truck, including parked cars and basketball hoops. Please remove carts from the curb after they are serviced on collection day. Carts are not allowed to be left curbside longer than 12 hours.



Help Keep Rancho Cordova Beautiful

Please remove your garbage, recycling, and green waste carts from the street within 12 hours of collection by Republic Services. The City of Rancho Cordova requires carts be placed in backyards, in a garage, behind a fence or gate, or placed in a location that is not visible from the street.

Moving?

If you are moving, please leave your garbage, recycling and green waste carts in a secure location for the next resident. To discontinue service, please call Republic Services at **(916) 638-9000**.

Extra or Replacement Carts

Residents may change the size and/or the number of their carts once per year at no additional charge. Each household may request up to two (2) additional recycling carts or two (2) additional green waste carts, or any combination thereof, for a maximum of five (5) carts, at no additional charge. Any additional carts will be charged extra. The size of the garbage cart determines your monthly fee. Recycle More, Reduce Trash, and Save Money!

Rancho Cordova residents have a choice!

Republic Services offers 32 gallon, 64 gallon, and 96 gallon carts for trash collection. Most Rancho Cordova households can use a 32 gallon trash cart if the recycling and green waste programs are used correctly.

Scavenging is Illegal!

Taking recyclables that have been set out for collection is called scavenging, and it violates both the City of Rancho Cordova Municipal Code and the California Public Resources Code. It is in the best interest of all residents to curtail scavenging!

Scavenging Hurts

The act of scavenging creates a public nuisance of noise and litter. In addition, revenue from the sale of recyclables collected by Republic Services is used to offset the cost of collecting these materials. When recyclables are stolen, potential revenue is lost and fees for recyclable collection may need to be increased.

How to Discourage Scavenging

- Put your recyclables out on the curb by 6:00 a.m. on the day of collection instead of the night before.
- Please do not give permission to anyone to remove recyclables from the cart.
- Report scavenging to the Police non-emergency line at **(916) 362-5115**.

Report Scavenging (Theft)

If you see someone other than the City or Republic Services employees taking recyclables from residential carts, report scavenging by calling the Police non-emergency line at (916) 362-5115.

Please keep reporting scavenging each time it occurs so the Police can establish a track record of the areas that might need special enforcement.

FREE Pickup Services

MEDICAL SHARPS



Republic Services offers FREE pickups of home generated sharps. To participate, follow the guidelines listed below:

- Place all home generated sharps (syringes, lancets, scalpels, and any needle or sharp object used for medical or health care purposes) in an approved sharps container and close the lid prior to leaving it out for collection.
- Pickups are by appointment only.

HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES

Republic Services provides FREE collection of household batteries on recycle collection day. Simply:

- Place household batteries (dry cell, alkaline, rechargeable, 9V, lithium batteries) in a quart size plastic bag (Ziploc) and place the sealed bag on top of your recycling cart.
- Batteries labeled as lithium batteries MUST be taped at both ends.
- The batteries will be collected on the same day as your recycling.

CURBSIDE COLLECTION OF USED MOTOR OIL & FILTERS



Residents can recycle oil filters and used motor oil curbside! Simply:

- Place used motor oil in containers provided by Republic Services.
- If you furnish your own container, it must be consistent with those provided by Republic Services (clear plastic jug).
- Tape lid to close it securely if you are using your own container for oil.
- Max. three (3) gallons of oil per pickup.
- Place oil filters in a Republic container or a sealable plastic bag (Ziploc) and make sure it is sealed.
- Place containers on the ground next to your recycle or green waste cart.
- Do not place the oil and filter recycling container on or in your cart.

FREE COMPOSTING WORKSHOPS

Republic Services and the City of Rancho Cordova are invested in reducing the amount of waste the City sends to the landfill. Republic Services and the City have partnered with Soil Born Farms to bring Rancho Cordova residents free composting workshops. These workshops are informative and hands-on. Residents will learn how to build, maintain, harvest, and troubleshoot a compost pile or bin. All levels of experience are welcome.
