COMMUNITY INPUT: Short Term Projects/Goals - Table Report Out:

- Electrical at Sunriver Park for events.
- Garbage cans not put away.
- Crime and safety.
- Gardens are okay, but not in the driveway.
- Code enforcement is slow to respond to the neighborhood. Take pictures of the problems.
- Homeless problems in residential and commercial areas.
- Renters are not being educated and landlord's don't help the situation
- Riding a mini bike in their back yard.
- Wrought Iron Fence along high school to prevent people from Jay walking on Coloma
- Klamath River speed tables concerns about traffic calming
- Apartments on Coloma, concern for crime, so raise the value within the community
- Restroom for park and keep homeless out of it.
- Sun shade over play structure at Sunriver Park
- Surveillance cameras for the City, coordinate a network of people who have private cameras, somewhat like a Neighborhood watch....network like Facebook page (Neighbors List)
- Gateway entrance signs and cleaning up the current signage and trim the trees that block its view.
- Par Course on Sunriver Park
- Infill development, center of it all, Tax relief for businesses to come to core of Rancho Cordova.
- More friendly biking lanes and conducive to pedestrians and bicyclist.
- Resurfacing streets appropriately, not just slurry seals. After utilities are put in and spend the extra bucks to fix the roads correctly.
- RT stations kept in better condition.
- Shopping Center development, Sun River

- Image improvement and code enforcement
- Bathroom in Sun River Park, host soccer tournament and it's a health and safety issue. Park hosts idea. American River Parkway restrooms need to be put back and we need to highlight the Rancho Cordova area. Replace opportunity, no picnic tables, field to play soccer or have fun
- Civic Light Orchestra, need a performance spot. Community Center for outdoor and indoor.
- Bike Trail connection crosswalk on Zinfandel, gap needs to be filled in.
- Car wash on McGregor, trash from carwash would blow into yards. Owner needs to clean up the area and maintain it.
- Business incentives available
