

# Free Bulky Item Pickup Program - 3 Per Year

Republic Services® offers up to 3 FREE bulky item pickups per year. Remember to call Republic Services at (916) 638-9000 to schedule a pickup before you pile your items in the street.

## ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS

- Appliances
- BBQs
- Bagged leaves
- Branches (maximum 4 inches in diameter and 6 feet in length)
- Carpets
- Computers, monitors, fax machines, printers, cell phones and other e-waste
- Furniture (chairs, sofas, dining tables)
- Mattresses
- Microwave ovens
- Plastic pipes (maximum 6 feet in length)
- Televisions
- Tires
- Toys
- Wood (including lumber and disassembled fencing)
- Lawn mowers (empty fuel tank)

## UNACCEPTABLE MATERIALS

- Automobiles or auto parts
- Boats or boat parts
- Backyard spas
- Batteries of any kind
- Bullets, shells and explosives
- Construction materials (asphalt, concrete, dirt, rocks, bricks, sheetrock, roofing material)
- Large tree stumps
- Medical waste
- Pool chemicals
- Propane tanks
- Steel pipes
- Hazardous waste of any kind (paint, pesticides, cleaning products)



## GUIDELINES

- Pile must not exceed 10 cubic yards (10'x7'x4').
- Items must be out by 6:00 AM in front of your house on your scheduled collection day, and no sooner than 24 hours before the pickup.
- Items must be 6 feet from vehicles and 3 feet from carts.
- Do not place items in the gutter, and do not block the sidewalk or road.
- Leaves and grass clippings must be bagged.



It is illegal to throw electronic waste (TVs, cell phones, computer monitors, etc.) in the garbage. Please schedule your bulky item pickup, and we will pick up these items for free. Just "Dial Before You Pile" at (916) 638-9000 to arrange a pickup.

## Bi-Weekly Recycling Service

### OK FOR RECYCLING



**Paper Products**  
White and colored paper, newspaper, magazines and catalogs



**Cans**  
Metal food cans, aluminum cans, aluminum foil and aerosol cans (empty)



**Plastic Film and Wrappers**  
Clean plastic film needs to be placed in a clear bag (empty)



**Cardboard**  
Cardboard boxes, cereal boxes, tissue boxes, egg cartons and clean pizza boxes



**Plastics Products**  
Milk jugs, rigid plastics, shampoo bottles, trays and flower pots



**Styrofoam**  
Clean styrofoam needs to be placed in a clear bag



**Small Scrap Metal (less than 10 lbs)**  
All-metal tools (wrenches, pliers, files) and aluminum siding



**Glass Products**  
Beverage bottles and food jars

Do not put any dirty or soiled items in your recycling cart. Make sure your recyclables are empty, clean and dry before placing them in your recycling cart.

## Bi-Weekly Green Waste Service

### OK FOR GREEN WASTE

- Branches under 4" in diameter
- Cut flowers
- Grass clippings
- House plants
- Leaves
- Shrubs
- Weeds
- Wood chips
- Yard trimmings
- Dead plants



### NOT OK FOR GREEN WASTE

- Styrofoam
- Palm fronds
- Rocks
- Sod
- Flower pots (ceramic and plastic)
- Pet waste
- Plastic bags
- Dirt
- Household trash
- Kitty litter

### HOLIDAY TREE RECYCLING

For three weeks after Christmas Day, Rancho Cordova residents can recycle their fresh-cut holiday trees at no additional cost!

Simply put your tree out on the curb on your regular collection day, and Republic Services will pick it up and recycle it.

Republic Services will NOT recycle trees that are artificial, flocked, or contain ornaments or other decor.



### EXTRA LEAF COLLECTION

From November through January, Republic Services will collect your extra leaves that don't fit in your green waste cart.

Simply bag your extra leaves in 30-gallon plastic bags and place them next to your green waste cart. Republic Services will collect up to 4 bags of leaves on your regular green waste collection day at no additional cost.



## Free Compost

Compost is available to Rancho Cordova residents at Republic Services' Recovery and Transfer Station. Please bring your own tools for shoveling compost, bags or buckets for collection and a tarp to cover open truckloads. There is a 3 cubic yard limit per customer per year. (*Proof of residency will be required.*)

# SERVICES: Garbage, Recycling, Green Waste, Bulky Items

## ALL YOUR RECYCLING AND WASTE NEEDS, HANDLED BY ONE PROVIDER

Republic Services provides recycling, garbage, green waste and bulky items services in Rancho Cordova. This guide provides details about these services.

### EXTRA TRASH

If you have extra trash that will not fit in your cart with the lid closed, please call (916) 638-9000 at least 24 hours in advance of your regular collection day to arrange a pickup of the extra trash. A Customer Service representative will provide cost and scheduling information.

### PAYMENT OPTIONS

You may pay:

1. By mail
2. With a credit card or checking account by calling (916) 638-9000 or (877) 692-9729, by filling out the form on the back of your invoice, by using the **My Resource™** app on your smartphone device, or by visiting RepublicOnline.com.
3. Automatically by checking account or credit card. Call for enrollment forms.

You may also set up paperless billing by visiting RepublicOnline.com.

### CART PLACEMENT

Place carts on the street by 6:00 AM on your collection day. Carts must be side-by-side and 3 feet from each other, from the curb, objects like mailboxes and basketball hoops, and 6 feet from larger objects like cars. Please remove carts from the curb within 12 hours of service.



### HELP KEEP RANCHO CORDOVA BEAUTIFUL

Carts must be placed in backyards, in a garage, behind a fence or gate, or placed in a location that is not visible from the street.

### MOVING?

If you are moving, please leave your garbage, recycling and green waste carts in a secure location for the next resident. To discontinue service, please call Republic Services at (916) 638-9000.

### EXTRA OR REPLACEMENT CARTS

Residents may change the size and/or the number of their carts once per year at no additional charge. Each household may request up to 1 additional recycling cart or 1 additional green waste cart at no additional charge. Any additional carts will be charged extra. ## Scavenging is Illegal!

Taking recyclables that have been set out for collection is called scavenging, and it violates both the City of Rancho Cordova Municipal Code and the California Public Resources Code. It is in the best interest of all residents to curtail scavenging!

## Report Scavenging (Theft)

If you see someone other than the City or Republic Services employees taking recyclables from residential carts, report it by calling the Rancho Cordova Police Department non-emergency line at (916) 362-5115.

Please keep reporting scavenging each time it occurs so the Rancho Cordova Police Department can establish a track record of the areas that might need special enforcement.

## FREE Pickup Service

### MEDICAL SHARPS



Republic Services provides FREE collection of home-generated sharps. To participate, follow the guidelines listed below:

- Place all home-generated sharps (syringes, lancets, scalpels, and any needle or sharp object used for medical or health care purposes) in an approved sharps container and close the lid prior to leaving it out for collection.
- Pickups are by appointment only.
- To request a free sharps container, schedule a pickup or for more information, call Republic Services at (916) 638-9000.
- Residents also have the option to mail back their sharps for a fee. Visit [RepublicServices.com](http://RepublicServices.com) for more information.

### CURBSIDE COLLECTION OF USED MOTOR OIL & FILTERS



Republic Services provides FREE collection of used motor oil and filters. To participate, follow the guidelines listed below:

- Place used motor oil in containers provided by Republic Services, or use your own clear plastic jug.
- Tape lid to close it securely, if you are using your own container for oil.
- Maximum of 3 gallons of oil per pickup.
- Place oil filters in a Republic Services container or a sealable plastic bag (such as Ziploc) and make sure it is sealed.
- Place containers on the ground next to your recycle or green waste cart.
- Do not place the oil or filter recycling container on or in your cart.
- To request FREE oil and oil filter containers, call (916) 638-9000.

### HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES

Republic Services provides FREE collection of household batteries on collection day. Simply:

- Place household batteries (dry cell, alkaline, rechargeable, 9V, lithium batteries) in a sealable plastic bag (such as Ziploc) and place the sealed bag on top of your recycling cart on the same day as your recycling collection.
- Batteries labeled as lithium batteries MUST be taped at both ends.
- The batteries will be collected on the same day as your recycling.



### FREE COMPOSTING WORKSHOPS

Composting is a great way to reduce your garbage by turning food scraps into soil. Want to learn how? Attend a FREE composting workshop at Soil Born Farms in Rancho Cordova. These workshops are informative and hands-on. Residents will learn how to build, maintain, harvest and troubleshoot a compost pile or bin. All levels of experience are welcome.
