The Mather Heritage Trail is a new 1.4-mile bike and walking trail that starts at the Mather Field/Mills Light Rail Station, crosses Highway 50, and continues to the Mather Commerce Center in the City of Rancho Cordova. The trail creates a beautiful new amenity, as well as a safe, convenient route for bicyclists and pedestrians. The trail also includes new lighting and landscaping, as well as 200 new trees.
