



Self-Certification of Compliance with Senate Bill 407 (2009) – Water-Conserving Plumbing Fixtures

As of January 1, 2014, a new state law, Senate Bill 407 (2009), goes into effect and applies to all single family homes built prior to 1994. This legislation requires water-conserving plumbing fixtures be installed throughout the home as a condition of finalizing building permits applied for after January 1, 2014.

This self-certification may be used in lieu of a city building inspector verifying compliance with the replacement of non-compliant water fixtures for areas of the house not included in the scope of work for the issued permit.

The water conservation requirements are:

- All toilets use no more than 1.6 gallons of water per flush
- All showerheads flow no more than 2.5 gallons per minute
- All interior faucets emit no more than 2.2 gallons per minute
