



LOOKING TO CREATE OR EXPAND YOUR OUTDOOR SPACE?

On Monday, July 13, Governor Gavin Newsom announced that all counties on the State's County Monitoring List for three consecutive days, including Sacramento County, are required to close indoor operations for certain industries and activities. On July 14, Sacramento County released a revised [Public Health Order](#) that is in alignment with the Governor's announcement.

The City of Rancho Cordova wants to work with you to:

- Allow temporary closure of certain spaces at your business site, such as parking areas, drive aisles, etc. to create new or additional outdoor space so that your business can operate outdoors.
- Not count this additional outdoor space towards city parking requirements.
- Review your outdoor operations plan free of charge.
