The Cordova Pride Project is a program that benefits any Rancho Cordova resident who is in need and lives in an owner-occupied, single-family dwelling. There is no cost to the selected recipients of the program.

Each project may include one-time home beautification projects such as: front yard improvements, landscaping, fence repair, garbage cleanup and general beautification.

The goal of the Cordova Pride Project is to improve our community one home at a time, and build stronger communities by helping a homeowner in need. We believe our city is a great place to live. By helping out our neighbors, together, we can make Rancho Cordova a place to be even more proud to call home.
